



CUSTOMERS OF SUN PRAIRIE UTILITIES

Sun Prairie Utilities has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase electric rates. The adjustment is necessary in order to cover costs associated with the Business Park substation as detailed in PSC docket #5810-CE-109. It also covers inflationary increases in operation and maintenance expenses that will allow the utility to continue providing reliable and quality service to its customers. The last electric rate increase was approved in October 2019.

The utility is requesting an overall increase above the electric utility's present revenues of 4.37%, or \$1,441,958. This request is detailed in Sun Prairie Utilities' electric rate application submitted to the PSCW on December 20, 2022. After review, Commission staff proposed a revised increase in rates of \$1,314,917 or 3.98%. The actual change to individual customers will vary with electricity usage, class of service and the ultimate rates authorized by the Commission. If the application is approved by the PSCW, per staff recommendation, the average residential customer using 636 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity per month will see a monthly increase of approximately \$2.40, or 3.0%.

A hearing on the application has been scheduled for Wednesday, November 1, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. (CDT). This virtual hearing has no physical location at PSCW's office in Madison, WI; however, the utility will have a physical location in the Commission Room at 125 West Main Street in Sun Prairie, Wisconsin.
